

A NOTE FROM TODD


We live in a time where everyone is telling us what to be afraid of and insisting that things are moving in the wrong direction. I want our Pathway family to know that, while I believe our world is facing serious challenges, personally, I am seeing and hearing amazing stories of life transformation! Stories from those who have been baptized over the past year, who have joined a group for the first time, who shared their faith with a neighbor who came and sat with them during services, and inmates being set free and following Jesus. So many stories of life moving in the right direction! Everyone Walks With Someone isn't a new thing, but an old thing that Jesus taught us. Pathway family, we are seeing this lived out in our church and community; God is moving!

When Jesus talked about His movement, He said those who followed Him would take His message anywhere and everywhere (Matthew 28:19-20). 2023-24 saw the launch of a strategy called "Pathway Anywhere"; the starting of micro-campuses in places where people may not have access to a healthy, thriving church. We have started 5 in the past year at: the Hutchinson Correctional Facility, Sedgwick County Work Release, Sedgwick County Jail, Oxford Villa Senior Retirement Center, and Oxford Grand Assisted Living Center. These micro-campuses are led by volunteer campus leaders who guide teams from our Westlink, Goddard, and Valley Campuses, impacting lives for Jesus every week. God is moving! We can report this year that more people have been baptized into Jesus at Pathway Church than at any other time in our history!

Additionally, we are hearing powerful stories about what is happening in our NextGen ministry. Over the past year, our Kids and Student areas have been focused on partnering with parents, helping them become the spiritual influencers God has called them to be. During our series Pass it On in June, a dad shared with me that, for the first time in his life, he began praying with his 8 and 6-year-old daughters. With tears in his eyes, he said he had never done this before, but after that first night, they asked him to pray again the next night. This led to spiritual conversations with his daughters. He told me he never thought he would be a good spiritual influence for his family, but now, with encouragement and God's help, he is growing and trying. I am so proud of our leaders and staff who have encouraged parents like this young dad to take a step. His family and the kingdom of God will be different because we all focused on passing it on.







SPIRITUAL LIFE SURVEY RESULTS




Local Outreach Served locally in the community...




