

USE WEST ENTRANCE TO PATHWAY CHURCH!

Kidslink has exclusive use (with a few exceptions) to the west side of Pathway Church and will have arrival/dismissal from the west exterior doors. Classes have been assigned different entrance doors and areas. We have a map that shows where each class will meet. Teachers will be at their designated doors for approximately 10 minutes until most of the class has arrived. If you are late in arriving, please bring your child in through the East Entrance and ring our doorbell for access. Preschool Hallway doors will be locked while children are in class.




Socks and Sneakers

Those flip-flops are adorable. Your sandals are so cute. And you look very stylish in your clogs and cowboy boots.

But when you're on the playground where there's dirt and stones and rocks.

the safest things for you to wear are sneakers and some socks!









The best shoes to wear to preschool are athletic shoes! Your child will be able to play on all the playground equipment if they wear closed toed athletic shoes. While we do not prohibit children from wearing other types of footwear, certain pieces of our outside playground equipment will be unavailable to them on the days they choose to wear flip-flops or sandals. Boots can be difficult for the children to navigate safely on the playground as well. Parents can help by establishing a routine from the very first day of preschool by telling your children to "put on your school shoes", which are athletic shoes!
