WHAT WE SET OUT TO DO

MISSION ADVANCEMENT

New LIFE NOW

\$11 million over two years (operating budget)

At the heart of *All Things New* is a vision to grow strong, deep roots that support lasting, life-changing ministry. Now at the midpoint of our journey, we're seeing how the core of our mission - the steady, ongoing generosity of our church family - is what allows the entire tree to thrive. It is the steady source of strength that supports every branch of ministry: weekend experiences that help people see God is one step away, thriving Next Gen environments that equip parents to pass on faith, intentional next steps where everyone walks with someone, and the operational foundation that holds it all together. What we've planted is beginning to bear fruit, and as we keep growing, we believe the most powerful impact is still ahead.



OLD THINGS *New*

\$2.5 million over two years

Healthy growth requires deep roots, and sometimes, renewing what's already been planted. As we dream about the future, we also care deeply for the spaces that have shaped countless lives already. Our facilities are more than buildings; they're places where people gather, worship, and take their next steps with Jesus.



To make room for future growth and create an environment where new life can thrive, we're stepping into a full refresh of key spaces at Westlink—including the Worship Center, Atriums, IGNITE Center, and Ball Park. Meanwhile, at our Goddard Campus,

enhancements to the Atrium and Kids area will help create a more welcoming, engaging experience for families and guests.

We believe these spaces are like branches of a growing tree, each one extending the reach of the gospel and creating room for people to encounter Jesus, take root, and grow in faith. As we invest in what's next, we're building for the future and trusting God to bring even more new life through these familiar walls.



New THINGS

\$3.0 Million over two years

Imagine a tree growing wide and tall, its branches reaching into new spaces, its roots sinking deeper into fertile soil. This is the story of our 10-year vision: planting 100 churches, welcoming 10,000 people into a relationship with Jesus, and impacting 100,000 lives. It's a bold vision rooted in faith, hope, and the belief that God is not finished with us yet. Right now, that vision is coming alive! We have planted all 15 of the micro-campus sites we set out to start! Small communities of faith



taking root in prisons, senior living centers, jails, and recovery centers. These branches are stretching out, reaching people who thought they were far from God, and inviting them into new life.



Across the globe, in Turkana, Africa, a new school and church center are rising, offering education, hope, and a future for communities longing to thrive.

But this is just the beginning of the story.

To see this vision fully realized, we're stepping into new chapters: building a permanent home for our growing Valley Center Campus, launching fresh micro-campus across Kansas, starting a brand-new Pathway Campus, and supporting a Church Planting Center in India that will train leaders and multiply churches. Each step forward is more than construction or programs. It's a living movement, a growing tree that will bear fruit for generations. Together, we're trusting God to grow this tree beyond what we can imagine, bringing life, hope, and transformation to communities near and far.

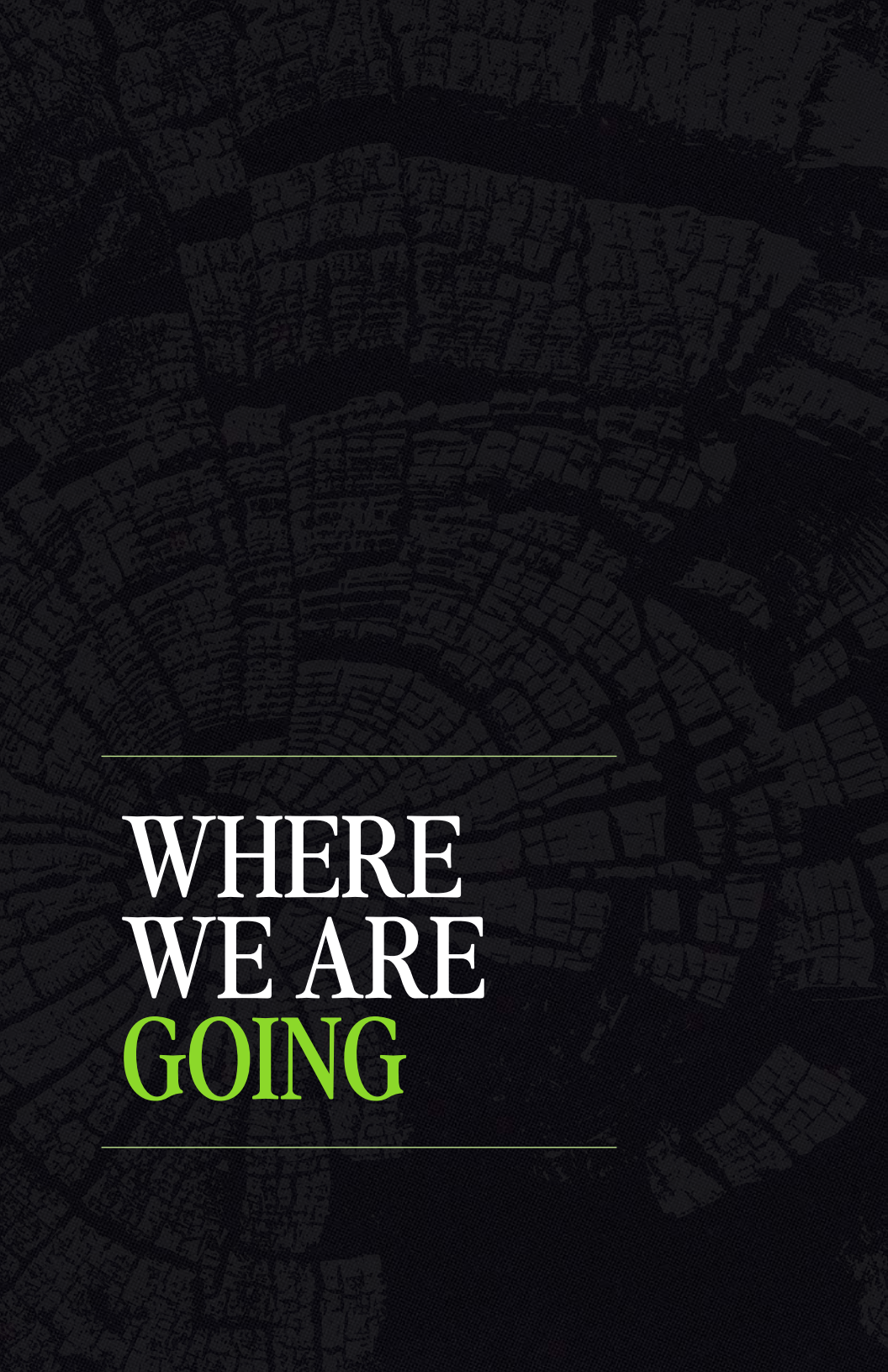

PRIMARY GOAL 100% ENGAGEMENT

Every part of the body matters, and every person at Pathway matters in this journey. Our deepest hope is that each person would grow closer to Jesus by taking one step in generosity. GROWING A HEART FOR GOD'S KINGDOM

Throughout 2025, the Lord has done amazing things to us and through us for our community and our world. He has given us every reason to trust Him, and we respond by honoring Him with our first and our best.

NEW COMMITMENT

"I am doing a new thing... now it springs up." – Isaiah 43:19

If you're new to Pathway, welcome! You might be hearing about *All Things New* for the first time and wondering how you can be a part of it. We're halfway through a churchwide journey of spiritual growth and generosity, planting seeds of faith and watching God bring new life. We invite you to prayerfully consider making a one-year commitment as your next step in moving God's mission forward and joining the story He's writing through Pathway.

FINISH STRONG

"...being confident of this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus." Philippians 1:6

One year ago, many of us took a bold step of faith—planting a seed of generosity and trusting God to grow something new in us and through us. For some, that step came with sacrifice and stretched faith. If the past year has brought challenges or uncertainty, you're not alone. Even in the struggle, God is at work. As we enter the second half of this journey, let's persevere and finish strong, trusting that what He began, He will bring to full bloom.

INCREASE

"... whoever sows generously will also reap generously."
—2 Corinthians 9:6

Some of us made our *All Things New* commitment a year ago, and since then, our faith or finances may have grown. Keeping that commitment hasn't been easy, it's taken real sacrifice. But maybe God is prompting you to take another step of faith in your generosity. Generosity isn't a one-time event; it's a journey. Ask yourself: *Am I still giving in a way that challenges me? Am I still making Him the ONE thing that drives everything?* Pray and see if He's inviting you to increase your commitment.

PRAY | JOIN US IN PRAYING EVERY WEEK! FIND OUT HOW IN THE WEEKLY GUIDE OF THE PATHWAY APP.

We know that anything is possible with God and that nothing is possible without God. Pray that God will work in your heart and the hearts of the people of Pathway, and that we will listen with the intent to respond.

ENGAGE | ATTEND EACH WEEK DURING THE ALL THINGS POSSIBLE SERIES (OCTOBER 25/26 THRU NOVEMBER 22/23).

Fully commit to what God wants to do in and through you during this season in our church. Devote this time to letting God develop commitment, vision, and generosity in your life. Come to church, answer the discussion questions, join in the events, participate in your group or join a short-term large group every week.

GIVE | START, FINISH STRONG, OR INCREASE ON COMMITMENT WEEKEND (NOVEMBER 22/23).

Our gifts will not be the same size in terms of dollars of course, but each of us can invest in a way that truly reflects the same level of love and commitment to Him from our hearts. Ask God to reveal to you what it looks like to give in a way that changes you and take whatever bold steps are required to see it through.

CELEBRATE | BIG REVEAL & CELEBRATION (DECEMBER 6/7).

God is going to do amazing things in your life during this season. Share your story enthusiastically with those around you. Encourage others as they take steps of faith and commitment. Celebrate what God is doing in the lives of others at Pathway.

IT IS SO EXCITING TO SEE WHAT GOD IS DOING THROUGH PATHWAY!

I consistently hear stories of God working in the lives of our Pathway family. God is moving at our micro campuses, ministry partners and of course our larger campuses in Goddard, Valley Center and at Westlink. I count

it a privilege to join God in what He is doing by participating in our "All Things New" generosity initiative. I heard a radio preacher a long time ago say that the gospel is free but that someone needs to put in the plumbing. I know that when I give of my finances it enables the sharing of the gospel across the greater Wichita area.

The truth however is that there have been moments during this generosity initiative that I would not describe as a privilege. These moments were quite the opposite, trying and confusing. Let me rewind back to our advanced commitment night. That night I had listened to a few people share about how God was leading them to give financially, and I was really inspired. These people were leveraging their finances in a big way to help advance God's kingdom. By the end of the night, I felt God calling me to increase my commitment and that's what I did. I felt really good about it; I wasn't just phoning it in. In fact, I really wasn't sure how I was going to make it happen, but I knew it was the right thing.

Imagine my shock to find out just a few weeks later that I had to find a new job. Within a matter of months my time in my current job would be coming to an end. You can probably imagine how I felt.

I was certain I had done the right thing by increasing my commitment but now I may not have a job. It was confusing to say the least. As my role at work was winding down, I interviewed for several new jobs. There was always someone else that was a better fit.

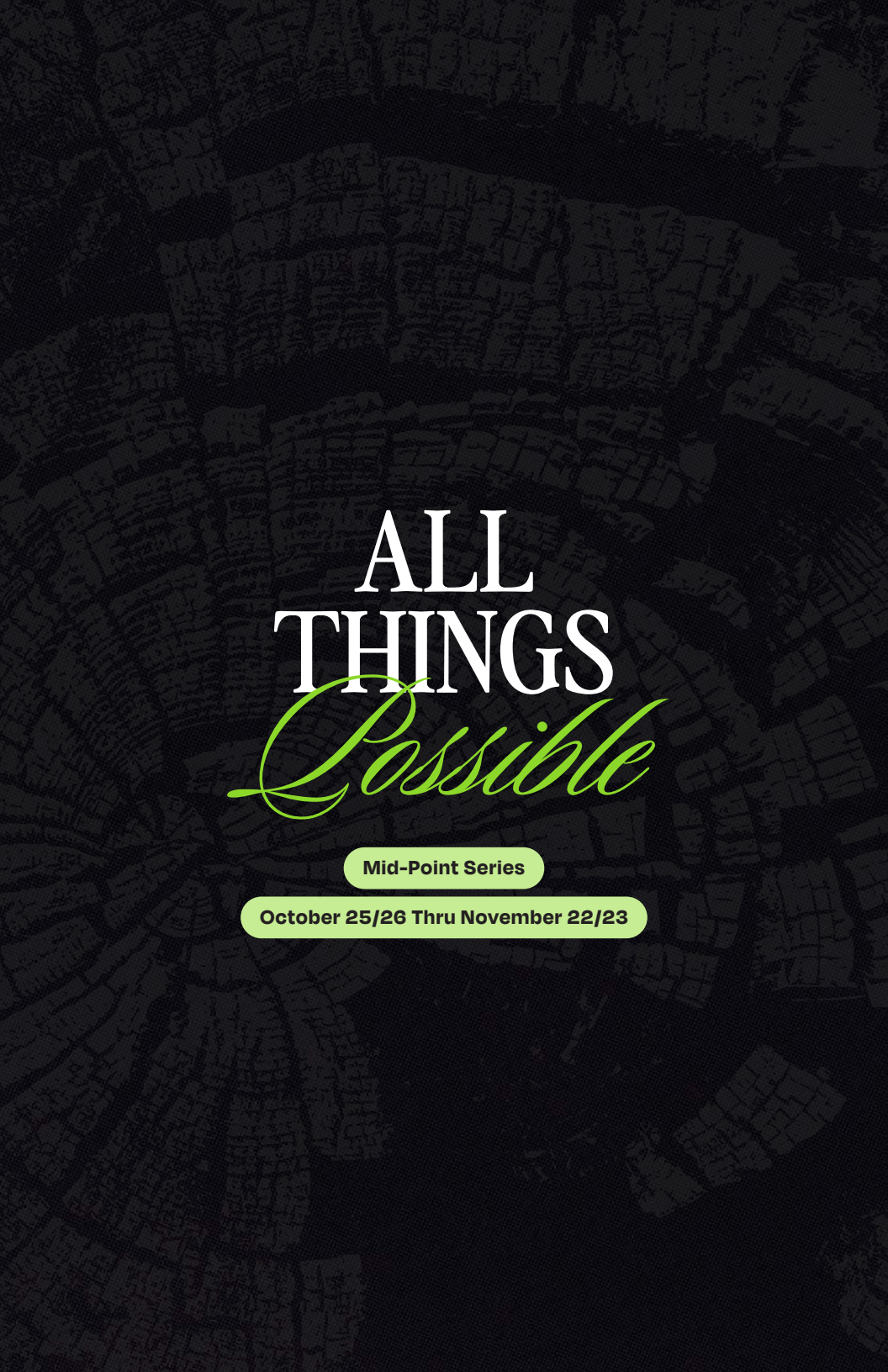
My two months of job searching brought lonely days, nightmares, feelings of failure, and doubt. I did my best to trust in God's goodness and sovereignty. It is certainly easier to say than do. I had seen God provide and protect many times in my life and needed to remind myself constantly that this time would be no different.

If my job search was a baseball game, it was the bottom of the 9th inning before finally landing a new job. Up to that point I wasn't sure what God was doing or what he had in mind, but it became abundantly clear. This new job was a great fit for my passions and skills, and I would be working with a really great team. Now for the even crazier part. This new job would come with a significant raise, enough to meet the increased commitment I made for All Things New! It was a total God moment. My wife and I have cried tears of joy on several occasions as we have reflected on this journey. Not exactly how I would have chosen for things to transpire but I wouldn't change it.

This experience has made this generosity initiative a very meaningful spiritual experience in my life. I learned anew about God's goodness and his sovereignty. I was reminded that when we desire to be used by God that He will make it happen. My view of God as provider has been powerfully shaped by many years of giving of amounts or at times that didn't make sense from an earthly perspective. I promise that God will grow your faith in leaps and bounds when you commit some of your treasure to Him. If you are already on our "All Things New" journey I want to encourage you to stay strong. He is faithful. God is using your gifts to expand the family of God across the greater Wichita area. If you haven't joined us on this journey it is not too late. We see in God's word His many promises to "make all things new". I hope you will join God in this movement. As you give He will do great things in you and through you.
